Sylvia Sparkis Endowed Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

- **Level of Student:** Preference given to graduate students, undergraduates may also apply
- **Academic Discipline:** Recreation and Leisure Services
- **GPA:** 3.0 graduate students, 2.5 undergraduates
- **Demonstrated Financial Need:** Evidence of financial need
- **Other Specific Characteristics:** Recipient will have successfully participated in at least one, and preferably more, structured activities that helped a person or group of people to better enjoy their lives, through recreational or leisure activities. Preference will be given to a candidate who has exhibited the rare skill and ability to help others develop their own talents, through showing enthusiastic interest in those talents and motivating them to confidently and passionately use their skills. The recipient should have the ability to successfully challenge others to grow and to avoid limiting themselves.

Stavres-Proctor Scholarship

Department: Department of Sport Management, Recreation Management and Physical Education

Eligibility Requirements:

- **Level of Student:** Full-time undergraduate student
- **Academic Discipline:** Recreation and Leisure Services Administration
- **GPA:** 3.0 minimum in all LEI prefix courses
- **Demonstrated Financial Need:** 3.0 minimum in all LEI prefix courses
- **Other Specific Characteristics:** Preference given to current member of Florida Recreation and Park Association and actively involved (attending meetings, conferences, etc).

Betty Palmer Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

- **Level of Student:** Full-time senior undergraduate or graduate student
- **Academic Discipline:** Recreation and Leisure Services Administration
- **GPA:** 3.0 minimum in all LEI prefix courses
- **Demonstrated Financial Need:** Preferred
- **Other Specific Characteristics:** Preference given to female returning students (a student who is attending college after being in the work force and/or raising a family). Preference given to student who has work or volunteer experience related to the field of recreation, parks and leisure services.

Frances C. Cannon Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

- **Level of Student:** Senior undergraduate or graduate student
- **Academic Discipline:** Recreation and Leisure Services Administration
- **GPA:** Undergraduate applicants must have completed 18 hours of LEI prefix coursework and earned a minimum GPA of 3.0 in LEI prefix courses. Graduate applicants must have completed 9 hours of LEI prefix coursework and earned a minimum GPA of 3.0 in LEI prefix courses.
- **Demonstrated Financial Need:** Preferred
- **Other Specific Characteristics:** Preference given to undergraduate students, and to those who have work or volunteer experience related to the field of recreation, parks and leisure services.
